

SADDLEBAG MOUNTING INSTRUCTIONS


Rear Sling with Underside Velcro

Front Sling

Side Pocket

Components

Pair of saddlebags Two raincovers Hardware—

2 #12 hose clamp snaps Velcro seat hook assembly

Fit-up of Three Point Mounting System


Sling Adjustments Follow diagrams A and B. Make the slings as short as possible for your particular seat. The bags should not ride low.

SPECIAL NOTE:

On motorcycles with mono shocks the saddlebags should ride as high as possible. Check to see if bag is able to contact wheel and shorten sling straps further if needed.




A To Shorten Sling



B To Lengthen Sling


WARNING Do not allow your BagMan

saddlebags to contact the exhaust pipes. Always ride with the bags properly fastened. Do not place more than 10 lbs. in each bag. Load bags evenly.



Attach as in diagram C.

3 Velcro Seat Hook
Use the bottom adjustment
to fit the hooks to your
seat. Compress seat
cushion with hand and
tighten securely. Leave as
much Velcro exposed as
possible for the rear sling
to mate with.





Place saddlebags on seat, mating rear sling Velcro to seat Velcro. Adjust the straps that fasten to the frame for proper length and snug fit, and snap in place.

Cleaning Instructions Hand wash with mild soap, no bleach, air dry.
